Dear All

Please find attached a copy of the cases downloaded and recorded for 2019. As well as your own data, you will notice that there is information on all UK centres. Well done to all of you that were able to achieve the minimum case numbers required. It is hoped that the number is a target that most of you will surpass with ease, although each centre has different circumstances, and to fulfil the case requirement is a proud achievement.

We have only included cases where we have complete pre-operative data available. A minimum of 12 cases of pararectal dissection with complete pre-operative questionnaire entered per named gynaecological surgeon in each centre is required to maintain accreditation. For some, this has meant they have not achieved the required numbers to maintain or become accredited. As every year, I would ask you to check the data presented below for your individual centre and if there are any figures that are genuinely erroneous please contact the BSGE Secretariat before February 14th otherwise we will assume the data to be correct and publish on the website as usual. Please bear in mind there may be some final adjustments to your exact numbers after some further inspection of the data. I would request that anyone who has lower numbers than they expected to check if they have a dissected case but have not filled in the QoL consultation Tab. For anyone who wishes to appeal, the process for this is on the website and any appeal will be dealt with accordingly.

As you will know, I have been eager to include follow up data. Our IT partners - ICE-IT - are managing queries related to the anonymisation transition and have not calculated the follow up rates as yet. For fear of delaying this letter further, I have taken the decision to publish the good news regarding your cases and will send out the follow up data shortly. I do hope that any anonymisation queries are being dealt with in a timely fashion, and please raise this with Atia if there are ongoing delays and frustrations so we can be alerted and prompt the IT team. Whilst you have all been patient with the difficult switch over, I want to facilitate things as much as possible to ensure continued engagement in the database project.

Finally, I want to let you know the Scientific Advisory Group have had a chance to review all of the videos you have submitted. For the most part they are excellent, and importantly follow the key required instructions. Atia will be writing to some of you requesting some amendments to your submissions, but this is the minority. In the main, it is often commented by the reviewers that the quality of surgery is perceptibly improved over the years, and this is great to hear, and testament to hard work, training, and the evolution of laparoscopic surgery for treatment of advanced endometriosis.
