We have great pleasure informing you about the BSGE Annual Scientific Meeting 2022. We are delighted that this will return to being a face to face meeting at the heart of the UK, in Birmingham's world class International Convention Centre (ICC). The conference will be streamed live to delegates who cannot attend the event in person. The meeting will be from Monday 28th Feb – Tuesday 1st March followed by a day of interactive 'Workshops' in Worcester and Birmingham.

This year's conference is entitled 'Standing Tall after the Fall' which truly epitomises everyone's resilience to get back on their feet and restore services after the challenges of the COVID pandemic. It is also our opportunity to focus on strategies to cope with clinical complications, complaints and litigation... 'Standing Tall after the Fall: Always learning, improving safety, enhancing outcomes'.

We expect around 500 – 600 delegates at this meeting which will include a program for the main auditorium and two parallel meeting rooms. These will include key note lectures, debates, free communications and 'rapid surgical tutorials' spread across two days. We will have a central exhibition hall for industry stands from our sponsors.

The ICC is a superb venue in the centre of Birmingham's vibrant canal district, surrounded by restaurants, bars and hotels with easy access to transport networks. There will also be a packed social program including our Gala Dinner on the 28th February in the ICC.

BSGE Corporate Membership with Industry Partner

BSGE Constitution states the following:

Corporate Membership (with a nominated specific person/link member)

Corporate Membership shall be available to Industrial Organisations or Companies, who have contributed to the development of the Society and who have regularly attended & supported meetings. Applications shall be made to the Council who will make a recommendation to the Society. Each company should nominate a specified person each year to be the link member with the Society. They will not be eligible to hold office or to vote, but can attend the AGM. They will receive the newsletters and have access to the website. Members of the organisation can attend the scientific meetings of the Society on payment of the appropriate fee.

Corporate Membership benefits
