

Requirements to be a BSGE Accredited Centre

(Finalised May 2025. Active from 2026. Review date May 2028)


Severe Endometriosis should be treated in specialist centres and the BSGE will accredit centres where gynaecologists work in appropriate clinical teams, audit their outcomes and have sufficient workload to maintain their surgical skills. The requirements to be a BSGE Accredited Endometriosis Centre are:

1. Consultant Gynaecologist(s) with appropriate specialist training and expertise to provide care for severe endometriosis.



Data Governance



- Level 1 ALL CENTRES
 - Basic data utilisation
 - Need DPIA acceptance for each hospital
- Level 2 CENTRES wishing to use for PATIENT CARE
 - eg for clinical / surgical notes
 - Needs additional agreements in place
 - CSO sign off

(10 Centres already signed up with ISLA)

Demonstration of how patients use QR submission:

(NB – not access to a questionnaire but shows functionality)



(NB - Please use 2000 as year of birth when submitting)

Next steps

• Finalise 2025 accreditation (cases / ? videos)

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- Centre Leads will be asked for (by ISLA / BSGE):
- 1) all users requiring access to database
- 2) DPIA sign off for basic utilisation of database (non-clinical use)
- 3) Decide whether to complete paperwork for enhanced (clinical) usage (paperwork from ISLA / BSGE for CSO sign off)
- All database users: Activate ISLA database log-in (Will be sent via ISLA / BSGE once notified by centre lead)
- Try out database (before January 1st) test patients for each centre
