Course objectives: To provide gynaecological surgeons with comprehensive training in laparoscopic myomectomy and in-bag morcellation techniques, focusing on safe, effective, and fertility-preserving management of uterine fibroids. The course aims to enhance surgical decision-making, demonstrate techniques for fibroid dissection, and enucleation of intramural, subserosal, and pedunculated fibroids, develop advanced laparoscopic skills including intracorporeal suturing and tissue retrieval, and promote best practices in reducing the risk of tissue dissemination through contained morcellation.
